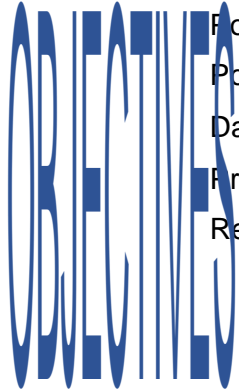

None of the above circumstances alone will prove that there is a sub-letting arrangement, as the legal situation depends on the facts in each case. While it is not always clear when a sub-letting arrangement exists, the difference between a sublease and a tenancy can be important if a dispute arises between a student and another tenant.
